The Declaration of Assent and the Oaths

Archdeacon In the name of our Lord Jesus Christ,

I shall now institute Simon and Louise, Clerks in Holy Orders,

as Vicar and Associate Vicar of this parish,

but first let Declaration of Assent be made and subscribed,

and the Oaths be taken according to law.

Simon and Louise stand before the Archdeacon, who addresses them

The Church of England is part of the One, Holy Catholic and Apostolic Church worshipping the one true God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. It professes the faith uniquely revealed in the Holy Scriptures and set forth in the Catholic Creeds, which faith the Church is called upon to proclaim afresh in each generation. Led by the Holy Spirit, it has borne witness to Christian truth in its historic formularies, the Thirty-Nine Articles of Religion, the Book of Common Prayer, and the Ordering of Bishops, Priests and Deacons. In the Declaration you are about to make, will you affirm your loyalty to this inheritance of faith as your inspiration and guidance under God, in bringing the grace and truth of Christ to this generation and making Him known to those in your care?

Simon and Louise affirm, saying

I, Simon Quentin Moore, I, Margaret Louise Moore, do so affirm, and accordingly declare my belief in the faith which is revealed in the Holy Scriptures and set forth in the Catholic Creeds and to which the historic formularies of the Church of England bear witness; and in public prayer and administration of the Sacraments, I will use only the Forms of Service which are authorised or allowed by Canon.

Taking a New Testament, they turn to the people and says

I, Simon Quentin Moore, I, Margaret Louise Moore, swear that I will be faithful and bear true allegiance to His Majesty King Charles the Third, his heirs and successors, according to law: so help me God.

Holding the New Testament, they turn to the Archdeacon and say

I, Simon Quentin Moore, I, Margaret Louise Moore, do swear by Almighty God that I will pay true and canonical obedience to the Lord Bishop of St Albans and his successors in all things lawful and honest: so help me God.

The Declarations are signed by Simon and Louise

Archdeacon Simon and Louise receive the Cure of Souls which is both yours and mine;

in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.
