



# 3Churches Rogation Sunday Walk Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2022

We are delighted that you want to join our 'grand day out' to mark Rogation Sunday in our group of churches, Silsoe, Flitton and Pulloxhill. Starting and finishing at Silsoe, the idea is to walk to all the churches with prayers outside each and a joint 3Churches Service at Flitton.

The route and timetable is as follows;

- 8.15-8.30 Gather outside Silsoe Church for prayers, depart for Flitton.
- 9.30 Bacon Roll breakfast at Flitton Church Hall for all walkers (veggie option) Toilets available.
- 10.00 3Churches Communion Service at Flitton Church
- 11.00 Walk to Pulloxhill
- 12 – 12.30 Prayers outside Pulloxhill Church, toilets and refreshments
- 12.30 Depart for Silsoe
- 1.30approx Arrive at Silsoe – optional picnic\* in the field on the way to Wrest Park – or go home!  
(\*you can bring a picnic and leave in Silsoe Church while you walk!)

### THINGS TO BEAR IN MIND

- We ask you to complete the registration slip below and pass it to Margaret Butt or one of the Churchwardens. This will give us a reliable list of who is attending.
- Please wear suitable clothing. The route is mainly off-road on public footpaths which might be rutted and/or muddy so good shoes are especially important. Bring water and plasters.
- Make sure someone you are walking with has a mobile phone for emergencies. We will not necessarily walk in one large group but we do need to keep track of everyone to make sure you are safe.
- You need a reasonable standard of fitness, there will be about 3 hours of actual walking plus 2 breaks. There are no very steep uphill bits but it's a gentle climb to Pulloxhill... - the clue is in the name of the village!
- Please familiarise yourself with the route before setting off. See the map provided. We will try and put a few discreet markers out but don't rely on them. Fortunately you can see your destination ahead of you so you can't get very lost.
- Dogs are welcome but must be kept under control - remember that there is a communion service along the way in Flitton Church where not everyone will be on the walk, well-behaved dogs on leads welcome.
- IF THE WEATHER IS VERY WET IN THE PRECEDING DAYS WE WILL HAVE TO POSTPONE DUE TO MUD.
